

## Fundraising Support Worker

**Background:** the Connections Bus Project (CBP) is a small community based charity providing mobile youth services to largely rural communities and Traveller sites in Cambridgeshire. Financial support is provided by local authorities, grant awarding bodies and trusts, and private donations. The charity now offers a unique opportunity for a volunteer to expand our fundraising activities to help support what we do for young people, and to meet the increasing demand for our services.

**Purpose:** to expand our fundraising activities through businesses, local organisations, community groups and similar initiatives.

### The role will involve the following:

- Promoting the CBP to local, regional and national businesses and organisations to encourage support and donations.
- Working with groups to develop and facilitate the running of fundraising events.
