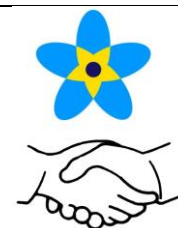




## Histon & Impington - Generation Game January 2019



### What is this course about?

This is a tailor made course to help you gain a basic level of knowledge, understanding and learning to be a safe and caring visitor for older people. As well as offering practical and hands-on experience, you will complete a portfolio of your work and receive a certificate on successful completion of the course, including First Aid.

At the end of the course, you will be expected to take part in voluntary work with older people in the community of Histon & Impington.
